Stamp Collecting Month Display

Friday, Saturday, and Sunday October 20, 21 and 22

John Coltran organized an eye-catching display at the Heritage Mall October 20, 21 and 22. Thanks to the Saugeen Club, the Kincardine Club, the Owen Sound Club, and Canada Post the main attractions were a bin of free stamps for kids, about 100 pages of beautiful philatelic items mounted in large frames, John and his crew of volunteers, and a table stocked with printed handouts. During the course of the 3 days several hundred members of the public had a quick look, and dozens stopped to chat, ask questions, make suggestions, or study the displays. Several thanked us for the chance to discuss their interests and heirloom materials in their care.

The Club appreciates the efforts and enthusiasm of everyone who helped make this display a great success.

Non-denominated Definitives

Canada Post has announced that non-denominated definitives will go on sale November 16, available in 5 designs in booklets of 10 and 30 stamps with pressure sensitive gum. The Canadian flag will be shown flying over scenic locations. The new icon indicates the stamp is PERMANENTTM and valid indefinitely for domestic use.

Stamp on the Envelope

The Committee on the Status of Endangered Wildlife in Canada lists over 500 species currently at risk. This year's set of 4 shows endangered land animals. The species are Blotched Tiger Salamander, Blue Racer, Newfoundland Marten, and Swift Fox. The sets to be issued in 2007 and 2008 will show endangered water creatures and air creatures respectively.

Designers David Sacha and Karen Satok of Sputnik Design Partners in Toronto have placed the individual against a fading background to symbolize the loss of habitat.

The souvenir sheet is unusual because the tabs are also stickers. On the envelope is one stamp with attached tab from the souvenir sheet.
