On the Cover...the 100<sup>th</sup> Grey Cup



It is July folks and you're getting the summer version of *On the Cover* this month. I am not going to go on and on about the wonders about Canadian Football, (I'm sure that you're all

dissappointed!) but I will say "Holy Cow Canada Post!" We got a series of of six over priced folders for the Queen's Diamond Jubilee, including a two dollar stamp that does not jive with any postal rates. A new zodiac booklet is released each month. The Lunar New Year stamp products are piling up to the ceiling now. You can barely stack all of your Titanic stamp products on top of that without damaging the chandelier so I just don't know where you're going to put all the Grey Cup stamp items.

The eight stamps on this souvenir sheet show the logos of the eight CFL teams. The logo stamps will generally be sold as coil stamps with each team logo available individually in coils of ten or fifty. You can also get a set of all eight in strips of four for \$19.52. There are eight cute little mail boxes to dispense your coil of fifty stamps.

But hang on – we're just getting started! In August another souvenir sheet will be released with a stamp picturing the the Grey Cup itself and a stamp for each team depicting a team member in action mode with a background scene from a particularly memorable Grey Cup Game (Ice Bowl, Fog Bowl or a team's first win of the cup). All of these nine stamps will be available in booklets of ten, as post cards and on Official First Day Covers. (What – no uncut press sheets!)

So prepare to go and talk to your banker because if Canada Post gets its way you're going to need a new wing on your stamp room! Enjoy your summer, I'm going fishing!
