2012 Club Business Report

At the last meeting the members present suggested that I add a report on some of the decisions that were made during the last number of months. The first major decision was to move the meeting location to the St Mary's High School. We have been very fortunate to be able to use the facilities for no rent and have meet in Hillyer Hall for the last three months. A couple of mix ups have occurred, including moving our meeting room for the December meeting.

It has been part of the clubs normal meeting to contribute a toonie for the meeting when they were held at St George's Church. Since the rent was \$20 a night, the contribution was helped pay for the evening. Over the first couple of meetings at St Mary's there was a question if we still needed to contribute at the meeting. After some discussion, it was decided to continue making a contribution for the club. What wasn't discussed when we made that decision was that several times a year we have club circuit books come and so we generally pay the visiting club some money to offset the cost of gas for the visit. The immediate benefit of joining the Grand was that the Cambridge club saw the show date conflict and so have offered us the last Saturday of September for our show and they will have their show on the second last Saturday of the month. Conflicting shows is a major head ache when trying to find dealers for the bourse.

Since this is December, I would also like to remind members that it is time to renew your membership. The dues will remain \$15 for 2013. The dues actually only covers the cost of the newsletters that you receive each month.
